Required

- Registered with Pennsylvania DCNR or registration from a reciprocating state. Contact DCNR Harrisburg at 1-866-545-2476 with any questions
- Liability Insurance
- Must be 16 years of age or older unless the minor possess a safety certificate and is under the direct supervision of a person at least 18 years of age.



- Persons 10 through 15 must hold a valid safety-training certificate issued or approved by DCNR and under the direct supervision of a person 18 years of age or older. Accident Reports

Both parties involved must exchange information. Include name, address and snowmobile registration number.

If the accident results in the injury or death of any person or property damages to the estimated amount of \$100.00 or more, the operator must report the matter in writing within seven days to the DCNR, Bureau of Forestry, P.O. Box 8552, Harrisburg, PA 17105. It is a violation of the Snowmobile/ATV Law to not report the accident to the DCNR

Caution

Many snowmobile trails are located on joint use roads. Users may encounter motor vehicles, dog sled teams, and cross-country skiers at any time.

Notice

Trail conditions may vary throughout the Allegheny National Forest and are subject to change without notice. Please obey all posted signage, stay on established trails, and yield to groomers. Please ride safe, ride with respect, and enjoy your visit to the Allegheny National Forest.
